Year R and 3 Admissions – As you may be aware, the application process for children starting in Year R reception and Year 3 infant to junior school transfer in September 2026 opens at midnight on **Saturday 1 November 2025**. Applications can be submitted <u>online</u> or parents can request a PDF version of the application form by emailing <u>admissions.team@hants.gov.uk</u>. Please be advised of the following:

- Name three schools on your application to maximise your chances of being offered a place at one of your preferred schools.
- Submit your application on-time, before the 15 January 2026 deadline.
- Use the County Council's <u>school catchment area finder</u> to check the catchment school for your address
- Read the school's admission policies to find out how many places are available and what criteria will be used to allocate places if the school is oversubscribed.
- Think about how your child will get to school. See <u>travel to school</u> to help plan your journey and find out if you are eligible for help with transport. You must name your catchment school(s) if you have one, as a preference if you wish to apply for travel assistance.




