Suggestions to help your child at home......

*Home learning - We are very impressed with the home learning that the children have completed this half term and look forward to seeing the children working through their home learning grid next half term. Please continue to encourage your child to have a go!

*Reading - Reading together at home is a fabulous way to encourage the development of your child's reading. Children will continue to change their books every Tuesday and Friday in order to build fluency, pace and comprehension. Phonics reading books as well as their phonics booklets will go home every day for you to use at home and they are expected to be in every day to be used in our daily phonics lessons. The children will be able to change their library books every Friday.

*Spelling - At parents evening we will be talking to you about the common word list which are the words children need to be able to read and spell.

Our learning during this unit will include....

Science

We will be looking at how most living things live in habitats to which they are suited. We will describe how different habitats provide for the basic needs of different kinds of animals and plants and how they depend on each other.

Computing

In this unit, the children go on a bug hunt, recording and identifying the small animals they find. They will then organise the data they have collected and answer questions.

Ρ

We will be focusing on the skills needed to support us with responding to music within gymnastics. We will be having a dance day where we will learn dances from around the world.

Geography

We will be going 'away' this term. Children will be comparing the key human and physical features of Chandler's Ford with Luxor in Egypt.

RE

We will be looking at light as a symbol during Diwali, Advent and within the story of Hanukkah.

Art

We will be looking at watercolour sunsets and silhouettes and creating our own.

<u>PSHE</u>

We will be learning about friendships and what to do if you think someone is being bullied.
