#### **Important Information & Reminders**

**Junior Flu Nasal Immunisation -** Junior children (Years 3–6) are due to receive their annual nasal flu vaccination on **Tuesday 25th November 2025.** Parents must complete the online consent form (School Code: **SH115884**) at least two working days before the session via the *Health for Kids – Hampshire* website.

The nasal vaccine contains porcine gelatine; families who prefer a gelatine-free flu injection can select "No" on the form for alternative options. Parents who do not wish their child to be vaccinated should still complete the form to update records.

**Year R and 3 Admissions** – As you may be aware, the application process for children starting in Year R reception and Year 3 infant to junior school transfer in September 2026 opened at midnight on **Saturday 1 November 2025**. Applications can be submitted <u>online</u> or parents can request a PDF version of the application form by emailing <u>admissions.team@hants.gov.uk</u>. Please be advised of the following:

- Name three schools on your application to maximise your chances of being offered a
  place at one of your preferred schools.
- Submit your application on-time, before the 15 January 2026 deadline.
- Use the County Council's <u>school catchment area finder</u> to check the catchment school for your address
- Read the school's admission policies to find out how many places are available and what criteria will be used to allocate places if the school is oversubscribed.
- Think about how your child will get to school. See <u>travel to school</u> to help plan your journey and find out if you are eligible for help with transport. You must name your catchment school(s) if you have one, as a preference if you wish to apply for travel assistance.

 Working hours: 7:30am-6pm (with restricted hours 9:30am-4pm between 8 Dec 2025–16 Jan 2026 and 24 Feb-21 Mar 2026)

#### Works include:

- Removing and replacing kerbstones at a lower height
- Resurfacing pavements
- Installing tactile paving at crossing points

Traffic management will involve temporary traffic lights (two-, three-, or four-way) at various sites. Disruption will be minimised, emergency access maintained, and information boards will be displayed.
