# Applying for secondary school places

Applications for applying for secondary school places for September 2024 open on **Monday 11**<sup>th</sup> **September 2023**. You can apply online at hants.gov.uk/admissions. You must apply to Hampshire County Council even if you wish to apply for schools in another local authority. If you do not live in Hampshire (including Portsmouth and Southampton) you must apply through your home local authority.

The deadline for submitting applications is midnight on Tuesday 31<sup>st</sup> October 2023. Applications received after this deadline will not be considered until after all on-time applications have been processed, which means late applications are less likely to be offered a place at one of their preferred schools.

Before completing your application, please read the online guidance on applying for a school place at hants.gov.uk/admissions. If you are unable to apply online, you can request a paper form and a copy of the guidance brochure by emailing the Admissions Team at <u>admissions.team@hants.gov.uk</u>

This is an event organised by Multiply, part of a government funded campaign to improve numeracy skills in a fun and accessible way. #### **Contact details**

Please can you notify us as soon as possible if any of your contact details change. You can amend your phone number and email address directly on Arbor but you will need to contact the school office directly to change your home address. This is not only to make sure you receive key information but also to ensure we can contact you in an emergency. Children should have three emergency contacts.

#### PE kit

Please can you ensure that children have their PE kit in school at all times. On occasion, PE sessions may be changed due to weather conditions or other activities happening in school so it is essential they have their kit available every day.

#### **Arriving at school**

Please may we remind you that the Junior school is open to pupils from 8.40am and the Infants 8.45am. This week we have seen some children arriving as early as 8.10am but there is no adult available to supervise until 8.30am. May we also remind you that children are not allowed to ride bikes or scooters on school premises, they should disembark outside school and walk round to the bike/scooter shed.

#### **Parking on Oakmount Road**

We have received some complaints from local residents saying they have been unable to get out of their drive during school drop off and pick up times. Can we please ask you to park considerately, leaving plenty of space for driveway access. Thank you.

#### **Absences & holidays**

• The school is unable to approve any leave for holidays/day trips/time off etc. These missed sessions will be recorded as unauthorised.

• If your child cannot make it into school due to illness or a medical appointment you must phone the school office by 9.30am.

• Children arriving any time after 9.10am due to lateness will automatically be marked as an unauthorised absence for the entire morning session.

Please be aware that if your child has 10 or more unauthorised sessions (morning = 1 session, afternoon = 1 session) over a 100 day period, Hampshire County Council will serve you with a fine. The penalty will be £60 per child and will be served separately to each parent. Once the fine is in motion it cannot be reversed. Fines will only be issued from the term after your child turns 5 years old.

# Collecting your child during the school day

If your child needs to attend an appointment during the school day, evidence of the appointment/s should be provided to the school office prior to the appointment. In order to minimise impact on your children's learning, parents/carers should ensure that routine appointments, e.g to see the dentist or doctor, are made during the school holidays or after school wherever possible. Please allow enough time to arrive at the school office so that a member of staff can call for/collect your child from class and sign them out. Your child must be accompanied by an adult when being collected and returned back to school.

#### **Snacks and drinks**

A polite reminder to please make sure your child comes to school with a healthy snack and plenty of water. Ideally this should be a piece of fruit or vegetables and should not be crisps, cakes or biscuits. Please also note that children are not allowed squash or any other sugary drink.
