WEEK!

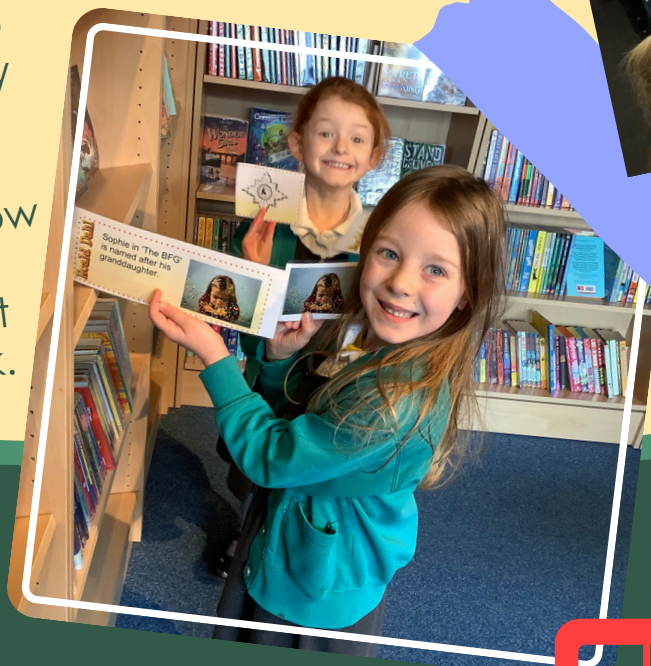
Some sporting superstars represented our school at a local Dodgeball competition today and we came second!!
