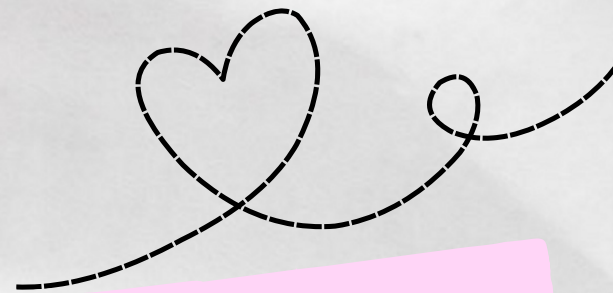

## 4 YEAR 2 MONEY, MONEY, MONEY!

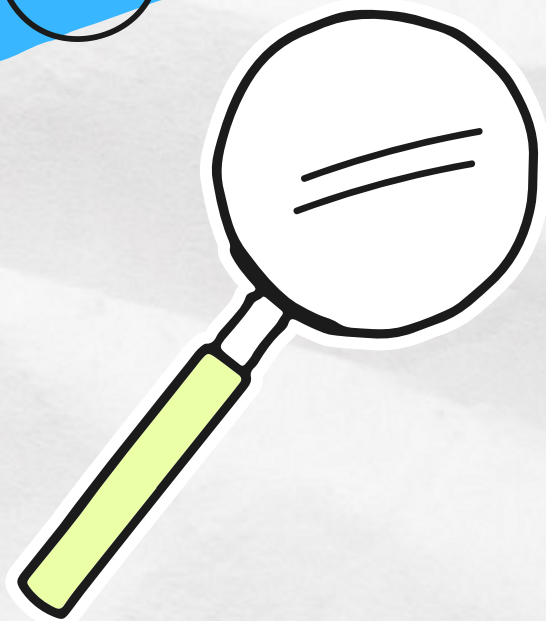

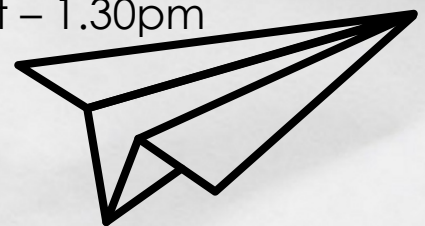
