#### **Free School Meals**

As a parent or carer, you are able to check online whether your child is eligible for free school meals. Further details can be found on the Hampshire County Council website, along with the link to the online checking facility:

Please note, whilst all children in Year R, Year 1 and Year 2 are automatically entitled to free school meals as part of the Universal Infant Free School Meals programme, it is important that we are capturing those children who are eligible to continue to receive free school meals when moving on to Junior and Secondary school. It is also important that any Infant age children are identified early to ensure they have access to free meals during holiday periods, etc. Please do check your child's eligibility. You do not need to let us know if the checker says that your child is eligible as we will automatically be notified.

### **Applying for Secondary School Places**

A reminder that applications for applying for secondary school places for September 2024 opened on **Monday 11<sup>th</sup> September 2023**. You can apply online at hants.gov.uk/admissions. You must apply to Hampshire County Council even if you wish to apply for schools in another local authority. If you do not live in Hampshire (including Portsmouth and Southampton) you must apply through your home local authority.

The deadline for submitting applications is midnight on Tuesday 31<sup>st</sup> October 2023. Applications received after this deadline will not be considered until after all on-time applications have been processed, which means late applications are less likely to be offered a place at one of their preferred schools.

Before completing your application, please read the online guidance on applying for a school place at hants.gov.uk/admissions. If you are unable to apply online, you can request a paper form and a copy of the guidance brochure by emailing the Admissions Team at admissions.team@hants.gov.uk
