Pathways

Thank you for maintaining social distancing and following the one-way system around the school. We are working with Hampshire County Council and the contractors to arrange a continuous path around the early year's area as soon as possible.

Carpark

Please can we remind parents that there is strictly no vehicle movement onsite once the front gates have been locked. This is particularly important at the moment as children and parents are using the carpark as pathways across the site to enable social distancing. If you do have a permit to park on site you must not move your car until the gates have been unlocked.

The gates are locked between 8.30am - 9.10am and again at 2.50pm-3.30pm.

Drop Off

Just to clarify, if your child's drop off time in the morning is 8.40am you are able to bring them in **anytime** from 8.40am right up to the start of day at 8.50am.

Likewise, if your drop off time is 8.45am, you can drop off **anytime** between 8.45am and the start of the day at 8.50/8.55am.

Year 4

On Monday 14th September Year 4 will be launching their new geography topic. Please can the children come to school dressed in summer clothes.

Year 1

On Friday 18th September Year 1 will be dressing up as 'People Who Help Us'. Whether you are coming as an optician, pharmacist, nurse or as somebody else, be prepared to talk about who you are dressed as and what job they do.

Snack

Children are able to bring in a small healthy breaktime snack such as fruit, dried fruit, cheese string etc. Reminder that there is no Select a Snack for junior children.

Bookbags and Rucksacks

Children are able to bring in a school bookbag to carry their belongings; these are available from the office for £4.50.

If junior children don't want to carry a bookbag they can use a plastic or fabric bag that can be folded up to fit in their pocket once they arrive. This is due to us currently not having enough space to store additional rucksacks in the class room.
