School Photo's

Infant photos will be taken on Tuesday 29th September and junior photos will be on Wednesday 30th September. Please ensure your child has their Fryern jumper with them. If your child is due to have PE on their photo day, please send them dressed in their school polo shirt and jumper with PE bottoms and trainers.

Every child will have an individual photo taken and also a photo with their siblings.

- If all siblings are infants these will be done on Tuesday.
- If all siblings are juniors these will be done on Wednesday.
- If siblings are across both schools, these will be done on Tuesday. This means anyone in Tanzanite, Diamond, Obsidian and Crystal **with an infant sibling** will also need to wear their PE kit as above on Tuesday.

We are trying to arrange a separate session outside of school hours for families however this is proving difficult with the current Covid restrictions. We will update you when we know more.

Dogs

Please can we ask parents to remind their children not to approach dogs they do not know and also not to unclip dogs they see tied up. There was an incident last week where one of our pupils untied a stranger's dog at the park, luckily the dog ran home.

Spare clothes

Please can all children bring in a bag of spare clothes to keep in school in case they get muddy/wet/have an accident. This does not have to be school uniform or a PE kit, just a pair of old trousers and a jumper will be fine.

After School Club

Coats

Although it's nice and sunny the temperature has dropped significantly in the last few days. Please can we ask that children bring in a proper coat as there are some with only school jumpers at the moment and they are getting chilly out on the playground.

Tapestry Year R

We use Tapestry in a slightly different way from preschools so please don't worry if you are receiving updates less frequently than you are used to.

Mornings

Please don't arrive too early in the mornings. The middle playground is used by Breakfast Club and the children may be outside playing until 8.40am. The infant school start time remains 8.55am and the junior start time remains 8.50am, the extra 10 minutes before is to encourage social distancing but arrival before this is not necessary.

Absences

- The school is unable to approve any leave for holidays/day trips/time off etc. These missed sessions will be recorded as unauthorised.
- If your child cannot make it in to school due to illness or a medical appointment you must phone the school office by 9.30am. If we do not hear from you with the reason for your child's non-attendance the absence will be recorded as unauthorised. If your child is self-isolating or has a confirmed case of COVID you only need to phone us on the first day of absence.
- Late children arriving any time after 9.10am are automatically marked as an unauthorised absence for the entire morning session.

Please be aware that if your child has 10 or more unauthorised sessions (morning = 1 session, afternoon = 1 session) over a 100 day period, Hampshire County Council will serve you with a fine (these can only be issued from the term after your child turns 5 years old). The penalty will be £60 per child, and will be served separately to each parent. Once this fine has been issued it cannot be reversed and if left unpaid it will increase to £120 per child, per parent. If this penalty is still not settled it will then be taken up with Hampshire County Council's legal team.
