Items needed (most urgent are highlighted in bold):

- **Tinned meat meals (stew, hot dogs, ravioli, curry, meatballs, spag.bol., beans & sausages etc.)**
- **Tinned ham & corned beef**
- **Tinned potatoes**
- **Cook-in-sauces**
- **Instant noodles / pasta sauces**
- **Tinned fruit, tinned rice pudding**
- **Sugar**
- **Custard**
- **Shampoo, soap, shower gel, deodorant, toothpaste & toothbrushes**
- **Laundry capsules, washing up liquid**
- **Dog food**
- **Nappies - size 6**
- **Tinned spaghetti**
- **Cereal**
- **Squash & long life fruit juice**
- **Desserts (sponge puddings, jelly etc.)**
- **Loo rolls**

While the Basics Bank are always grateful for any food given to them, they do have plenty of stock of some products to last for a few months, specifically: baked beans, soup, tea, tinned tomatoes, milk and biscuits. They also have plenty of nappies up to size 4.

Hand Sanitiser
