School Dinners

The new menus for next half term have been sent home via parent mail this week. They are also attached to this Newsletter email in case you missed it.

On Tuesday 2nd November there will be a slight change to the options, the choice will be a veggie burger and not veggie sausages.

Harvest Festival – Basic Bank

Although we were unable to invite all parents to the church for our harvest festival the children and staff enjoyed the celebration here in the new junior hall. Thank you for all your donations of food, the staff from the Eastleigh Basic Bank were overwhelmed with your generosity. It really will make a difference to many families in this area. Update on the Building and Ground works

As you are already aware the new junior school building has been completed bar some snagging issues and fully occupied by us since the beginning of September.

Ground works will continue over the half term, this will include:

- Landscaping in front of the new building
- Resurfacing of the 2 junior playgrounds
- Partial new tarmac in junior car park and road area
- Road access barrier will be installed on the driveway

Over the next month or so the area of field occupied by the contractors will be reinstated. This area will be reseeded in March of next year. The fitness equipment will be reinstated.

Solar panels are being fitted on the roof of the infant school, this will be completed over half term.

Solar panels were fitted to the junior roof during the build process.

Vehicle Barrier

Over half term the new vehicle barrier will be installed on the front drive and access to the site will be restricted to staff only. If you are a blue badge holder or need to drive in to collect an unwell child please use the intercom by the barrier to gain access. However please be aware that there is still strictly no vehicle movement between 8.30am-9.00am and 3.00pm-3.30pm, even if you are a blue badge holder.

Parents dropping off at Breakfast Club and collecting from any of the after school clubs will need to park on the roads outside.

If Breakfast Club parents are happy for their junior children to walk on to the site unaccompanied in the mornings then please drop them off on the main road. Infant children must still be brought to the hall door by an adult.
