**Increasing Data**

If you're home schooling but don't have home broadband or can't afford extra mobile data you may be able to get help. A temporary scheme means schools, trusts and local authorities can request mobile data increases for children and young people who meet the criteria. So far, the following networks are signed up: Three, Smarty, Virgin Mobile, EE, Tesco Mobile, Sky Mobile.

If increasing mobile data isn't a suitable option, schools can also request 4G wireless routers.
