



## Fryern Infant and Junior Schools Newsletter

### Friday 12<sup>th</sup> February 2021

Next week will be February half term and Monday 22<sup>nd</sup> February is an INSET day for staff, both schools will be closed. Work on Google Classroom will start again on Tuesday 23<sup>rd</sup> February. We hope that the weather will allow us all to take some exercise and enjoy the fresh air. Please continue to follow the Lockdown restrictions in order to minimize the risk of transmission of Covid-19. Whilst rates of infection are dropping we are still hearing of cases amongst adults and children in our own school community.

#### New Build

We are delighted that the work on the replacement junior school building has been able to continue this year. We expect to begin to take occupation of the building after the Easter holidays. It has been exciting catching glimpses of the colour schemes of the new classrooms. The plan is for 8 classes to be moved in by early June.

Over the February half term the main services will be linked to the new building. Following this, the linking canopy between the infant and junior buildings will be installed. In order for this to take place the current path between the infant and junior school will be closed, an alternative safe route through the site will be created (see map attached separately). We have worked with McAvoy (builders) and the county architects to ensure that we can maintain our one-way system and ensure appropriate safeguarding arrangements for pupils and staff during the school day. Cheetah class will need to be dropped off and collected from the hall doors. Once the school has taken over the new junior building, work will commence on creating the new federation office in what is currently being used by Aquamarine as a classroom. All refurbishment work should be finished by July and landscaping will be completed over the summer holidays.

Any completed home learning can be uploaded to google classroom or returned in homelearning books when school reopens.
