



New Guidance from the 19th July

You may by now have read the new DfE guidance issued on the 6th July or heard the various commentary in the media about the next stage of the roadmap to be implemented from 19th July. This makes it clear that schools should continue to implement the following mitigation strategies:

- Ensure good hygiene for everyone
- Maintain appropriate cleaning regimes
- Keep occupied spaces well ventilated
- Follow Public Health advice on testing, self-isolation and managing confirmed cases of Covid-19

All Hampshire schools have been advised by Simon Bryant, Director of Public Health, to keep the bubbles intact until the end of term. Due to this guidance we have made the decision not to hold a picnic on the last day of term.
