**Proof of Absences**

As a school we follow Hampshire's policy regarding leave of absence in term time and issue penalty notices on accordance with this policy.

Due to the high volume of holiday requests we have received this year, any absence taken for a wedding or other religious ceremony will now require proof for it to be deemed as authorised.

If you have requested a leave of absence for a holiday and then call your child in sick either side of this period (taking you over the 10 session limit) you will be required to provide proof of illness in order for a fine not to be issued.

Similarly, if your child is absent for a period of 5 or more consecutive days due to illness you will need to provide medical evidence to support this. This can take the form of prescriptions, appointment cards etc.

**Junior School Redevelopment**

You may have heard that Hampshire County Council has agreed to fund our redevelopment of the junior buildings. Planning for this redevelopment is at a very early stage and we look forward to sharing the plans with you in due course. In conjunction with the development we are also changing the use of existing rooms within the junior school to house the extra classes coming up over the next couple of years.
