



Following the Government announcement last week to push recovery back a month, we have also received further clarification from Hampshire on the safe running of schools going forward. Therefore, we are now in a position to clarify our position on a number of end of term arrangements. We have all done so well so far in helping to ensure the school is a safe place to be and the latest guidance is very clear – we must continue to minimise the risk of transmission by keeping groups consistent and our system of control measures in place.

### **End of year picnic**

Whilst this could be after the date when the country moves to the next stage of recovery it does not seem sensible, having been restricted for so long, to suddenly invite crowds of people onto site. The last thing we want is for families to have to isolate at the end of term or at the beginning of the summer holidays, potentially jeopardising family holidays because we relaxed our restrictions too soon, even if this becomes possible. We will proceed with the plans for you to be able to collect your child at lunchtime on the last day, however there will be no end of year picnic. We will plan a fun, in-house treat session for each bubble during that last week. Details to follow.

### **Sports Day**

We had really hoped to be able to invite everyone to join us for Sports Day, as we know this is an important occasion for the children & parents; however we are still unable to safely do this due to the requirement to keep adult bubbles to 30 or less and manage social distancing on site. Fryern Olympics will allow the children to take part in a range of events and to support each other. This will be a very special occasion for them. Year 6 are really looking forward to being journalists and providing daily updates to you.

## Transition

We have arranged two 15 minute sessions for the new classes to meet before the end of term. The dates for these are: Wednesday 30<sup>th</sup> June and Tuesday 20<sup>th</sup> July. These will be held outside and are weather dependent.

## School Reports and Parents Evening

School reports will be sent home on Friday 2<sup>nd</sup> July. Should you wish to book a parents evening slot to discuss your child's report further teachers will be offering a phone call appointment.

You will be able to request an appointment on Monday 5<sup>th</sup> July, a link will be parentmailed out. Slots will last 10 minutes and the teacher will call anytime between 3.30pm – 5.30pm.

## Absences & Holidays

- The school is unable to approve any leave for holidays/day trips/time off etc. These missed sessions will be recorded as unauthorised.
- If your child cannot make it in to school due to illness or a medical appointment you must phone the school office by 9.30am. If we do not hear from you with the reason for your child's non-attendance the absence will be recorded as unauthorised.
- Children arriving any time after 9.10am due to lateness will automatically be marked as an unauthorised absence for the entire morning session.

**Please be aware that if your child has 10 or more unauthorised sessions (morning = 1 session, afternoon = 1 session) over a 100 day period, Hampshire County Council will serve you with a fine. The penalty will be £60 per child, and will be served separately to each parent. Once the fine is in motion it cannot be reversed. Fines will only be issued from the term after your child turns 5 years old.**
