

# Year 1+2 Maths challenges for the summer



## Time

Make the clock and decorate it. Bring it back in September to share with the class and use during your maths lessons.

- 1) Tell the time to the hour.
- 2) Tell the time to half past the hour.
- 3) Tell and write the time to five minutes, including quarter past/to the hour.
- 4) Make a timetable for a day in the holidays. Draw the hands on a clock face to show what you are going to do during these times. Describe your timetable to an adult using this language to help:

before and after, next, first, today, yesterday, tomorrow, morning, afternoon and evening

## Money



- 1) Gather a selection of coins. Recognise their value. Can you order them from the least valuable to the most valuable?
- 2) Gather a selection of notes and recognise their value.
- 3) Set up a tuck shop and give each item a value. Can you pay for your snacks with the correct money or do you have to use different coins to pay?

## Times tables

- Can you count in 2s, 5s, 10s and 3s?
- Do you know your 2, 5, 10 and 3 times table?
